
Although the gallery took a pause over Semana Santa, the art kept moving.



Travel with us as we trace the journey of these artworks — from our walls to yours.



Ninfa Torres Lagunes, originally from Misantla, Veracruz, Mexico, was born in 1982. She earned her Bachelor's degree in Visual Arts from the Universidad Veracruzana in Xalapa, Veracruz. Since 2008, she has been a professor in the Visual Arts program at the Universidad de Ciencias y Artes de Chiapas. Ninfa Torres's work has been selected for various biennials and has received multiple awards. In 2013, she was selected for the 5th International Biennial of Visual Arts at the Universidad Autónoma del Estado de México. In 2012, her work was included in the Visual Arts Encounter of Tabasco. She was awarded a grant through the Veracruz State Fund for Artistic Creation and Development in 2010 under the "Young Creators" category in Painting.

Robie Espinoza holds a degree in Visual Arts with a specialization in Painting from the Universidad Veracruzana. He has held 10 solo exhibitions and participated in over 30 group shows, both in Mexico and abroad. He was a recipient of the FONCA Young Creators Grant in Painting in 2008–2009 and again in 2015. In 2012, he received a grant from the Chiapas State Program for Artistic Creation and Development (PECDA). He currently teaches in the Visual Arts program at the Universidad de Ciencias y Artes de Chiapas (UNICACH), where he is also pursuing a Master's degree in Practice and Contemporary Thought in collaboration with the Polytechnic University of Valencia.
