


## The Unveiling: Sebastian *Bours & Pablo Emilio Take Center Stage*

The Kuitca Grant and the Argentines Who Shaped a Generation In the early 1990s, in a workshop tucked away in La Boca, Buenos Aires, artist Guillermo Kuitca launched what would become one of the most influential artistic residencies in Latin America: the Kuitca Grant. Though still informal in its early years, the program brought together a group of young Argentine artists who, over the next three decades, would become key figures in contemporary art. Artists like Magdalena Jitrik and Graciela Hasper explored abstraction through political or emotional frameworks; Alfredo Londaibere and Sergio Bazán infused their work with spirituality, music, and personal narratives; and Fabián Burgos, with his kinetic, optical precision, challenged how we see and experience art.

From urban installations to murals in Miami and exhibitions in European museums, these artists not only pushed the boundaries of painting, drawing, and printmaking — they expanded what Argentine art could mean on a global scale.

Thanks to the visionary eye of Guillermo Sepúlveda, founder of Arte Actual Galería in Monterrey, many of these works arrived in Mexico just as these careers were taking off. This exhibition brings together some of those original pieces from the Guillermo Sepúlveda Collection — silent witnesses to a time when everything was just beginning.
